How to Be an Effective Parent: Cost \$190 Tired of arguments, lack of respect and discipline from your children? Improve your parenting skills, understand parental responsibilities, how to communicate effectively with your children, have order in the home and enjoy your family life. There are six counseling sessions designed for all caretakers parents including those referred by social services, judges, and other service providers. You must attend all six sessions to receive an attendance certificate.

Anger Management for Parents: Cost \$190

Anger is a normal emotion. Children learn early which "buttons to press". Learn methods of dealing with anger in a healthy, constructive manner as well as coping with the pressures of life. There are six counseling sessions designed for single parents, couples and caretakers with a total of 6 hours of anger management. You must attend all four sessions to receive an attendance certificate.

SUPERVISED VISITATION

Supervised Visitation provides contact between a non-custodial parent, and one or more children in the presence of a third person. This person is responsible for observing and seeking to ensure the safety of all those involved.

This service is available when the court has determined that supervised visitation occur in an environment that provides a high level of safety and security for custodial and non-custodial parent(s) and child.

Clients must be court ordered to attend supervised visitation.

Program fees are based on a sliding scale as follows:

12,000 and below- \$50.00

13,000-20,000- \$60.00

21,000-32,000- \$70.00

32,000 and above- \$80.00
